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

- Receipts should be itemized and not just reflect the grand total
- For meals, a list of the employees is required
- For conferences / seminars: please submit the agenda

\*Please note these are both Federal and State requirements, which is why Finance requests them\*





Temporary and permanent office moves will happen when the project transitions from the 2nd to 1st floors.


The Flooring project in the Extended Care dining and lounge area is currently on hold.
